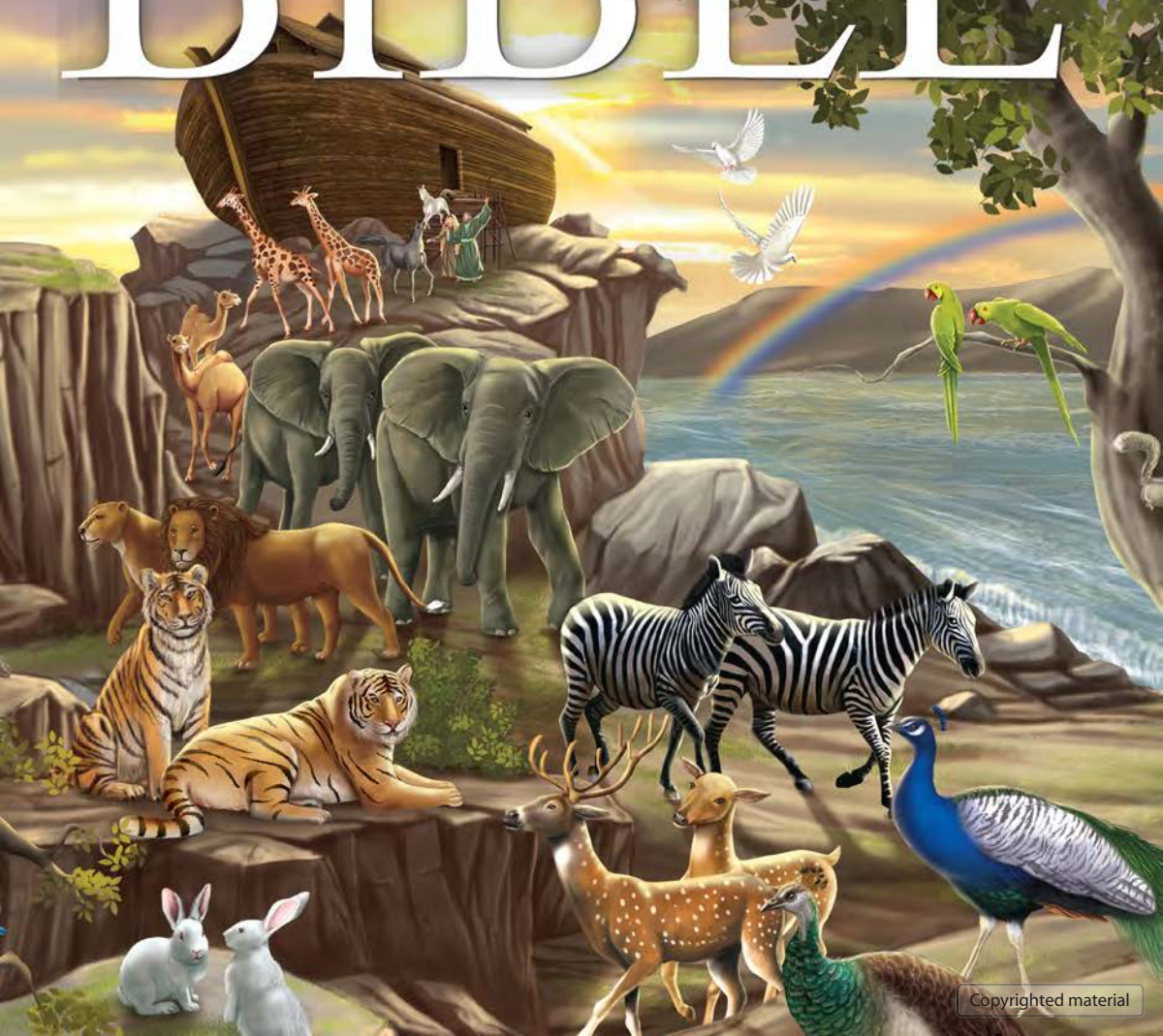

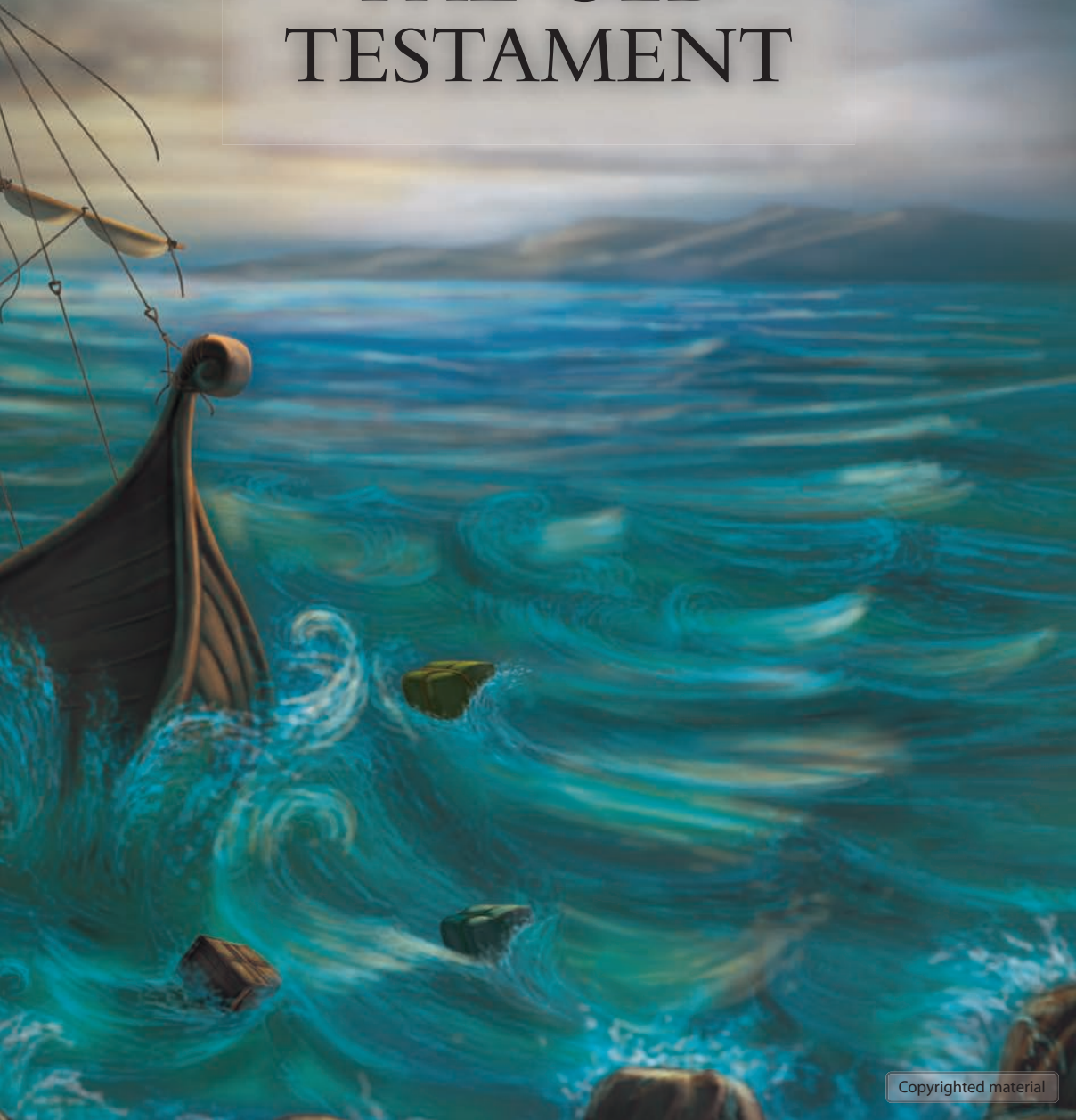

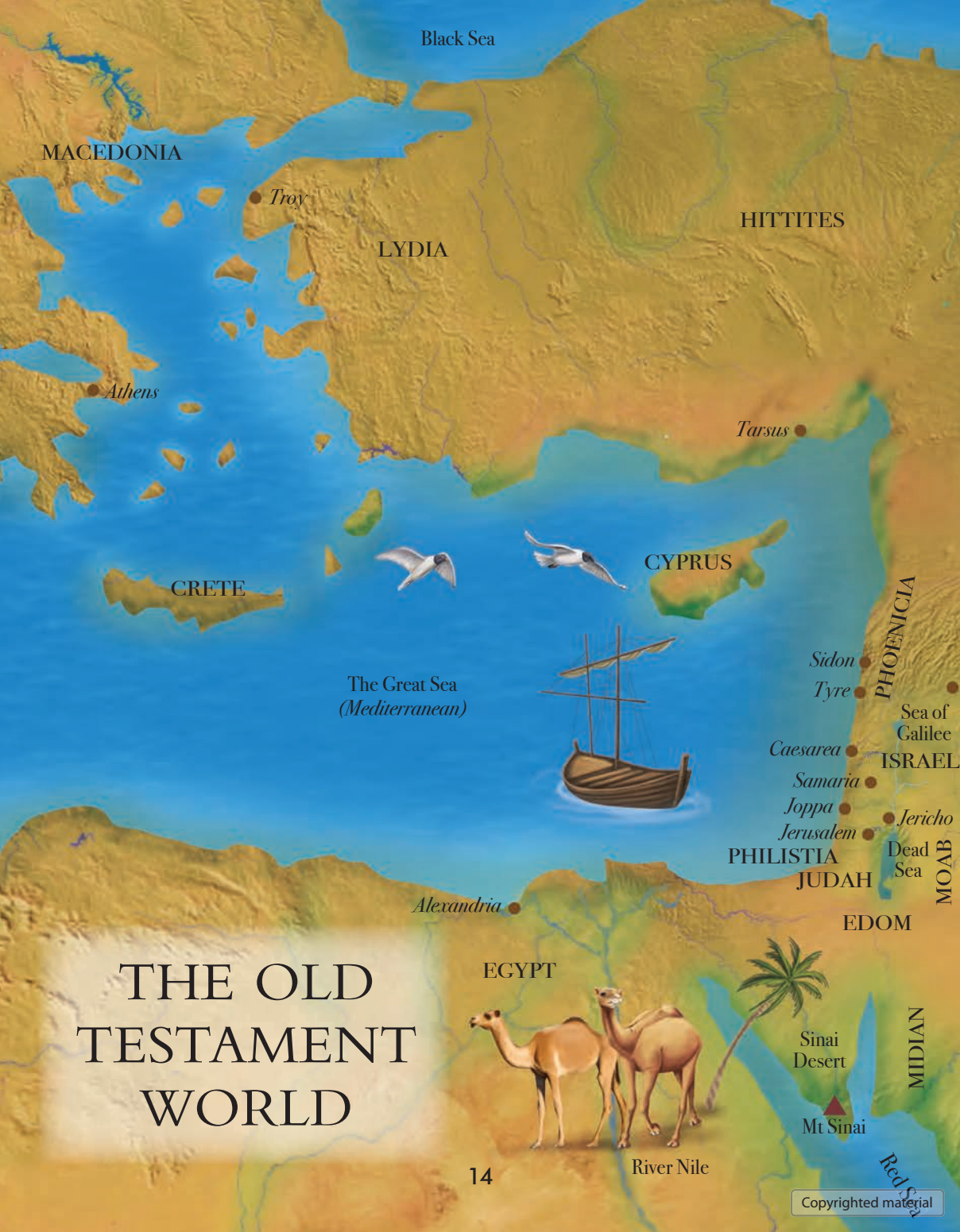

Genesis 1-2



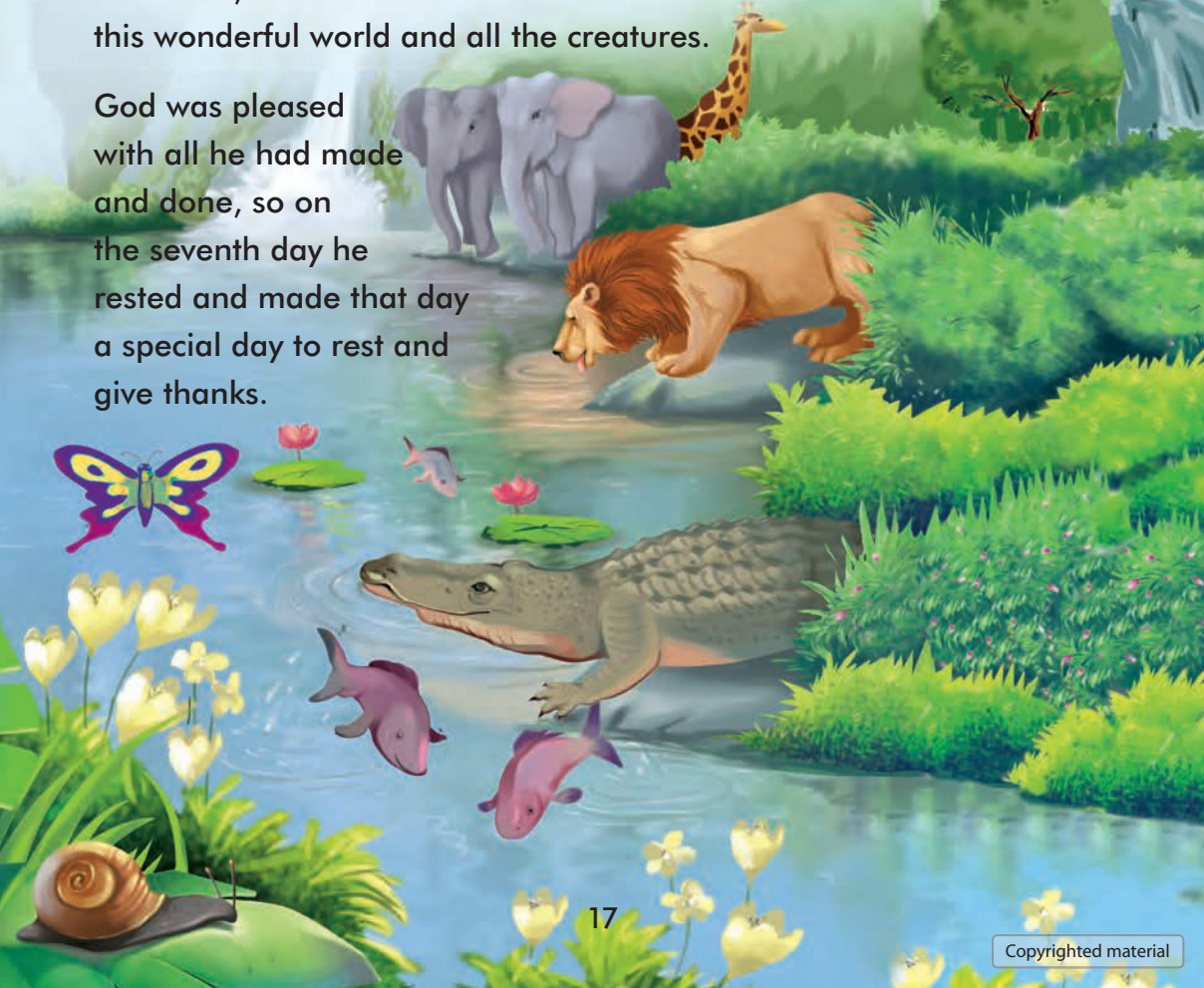

DISOBEYING GOD


Genesis 3

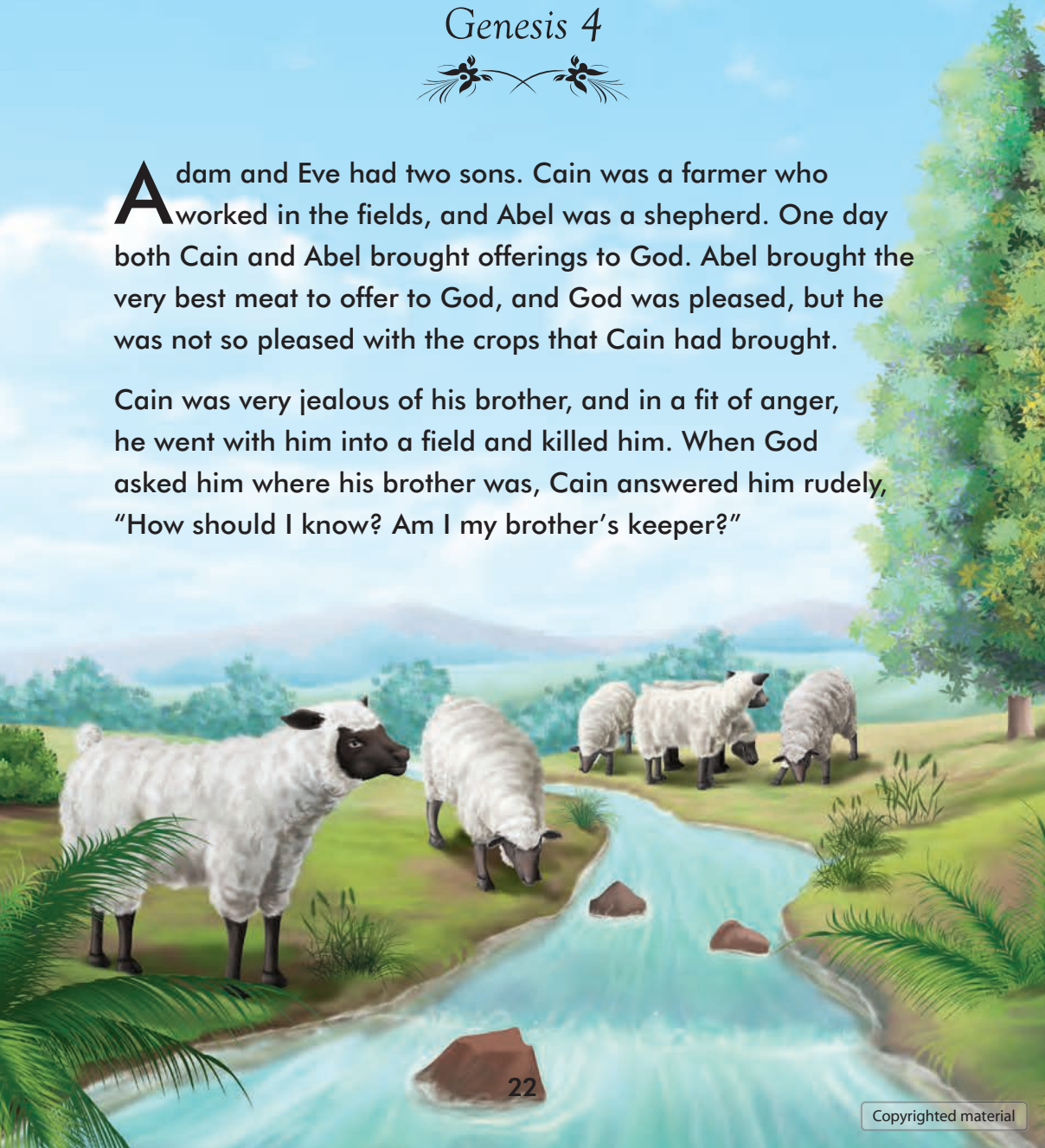
CAIN AND ABEL

But God saw Abel's blood on the ground and was angry. He punished Cain and sent him away from his home and family.



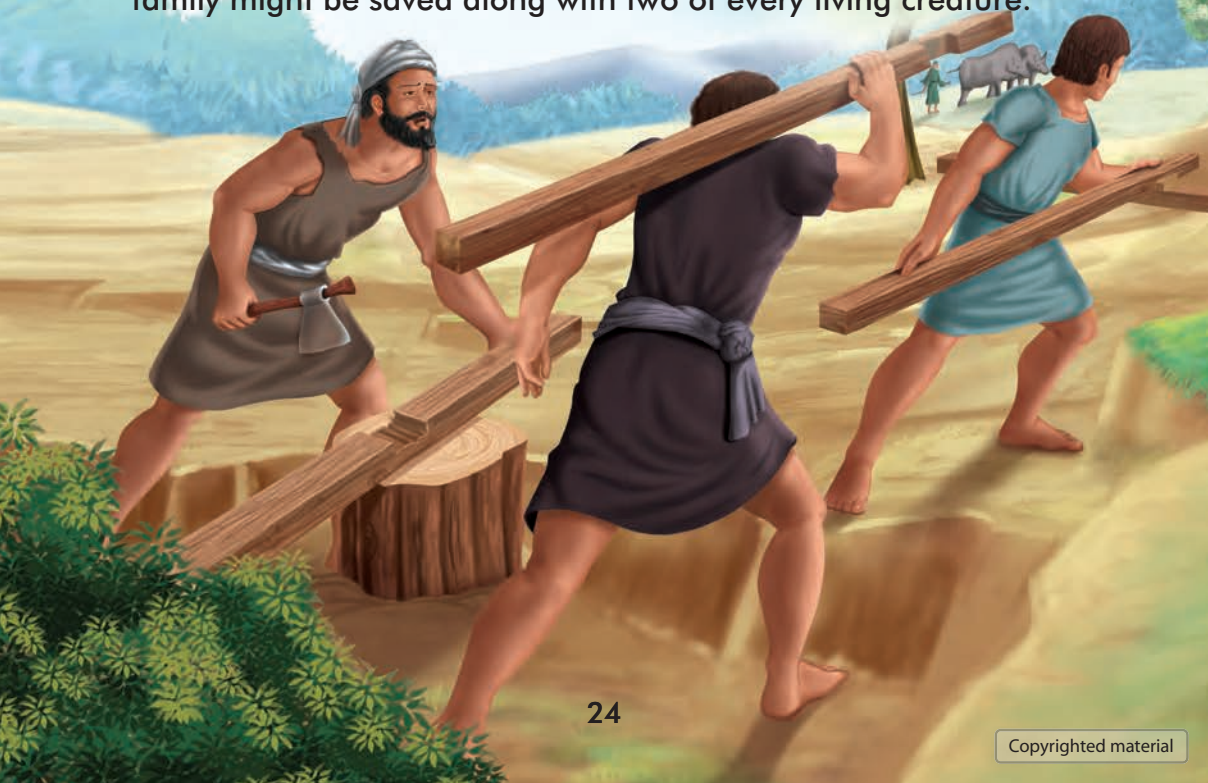
NOAH BUILDS THE ARK

Genesis 6

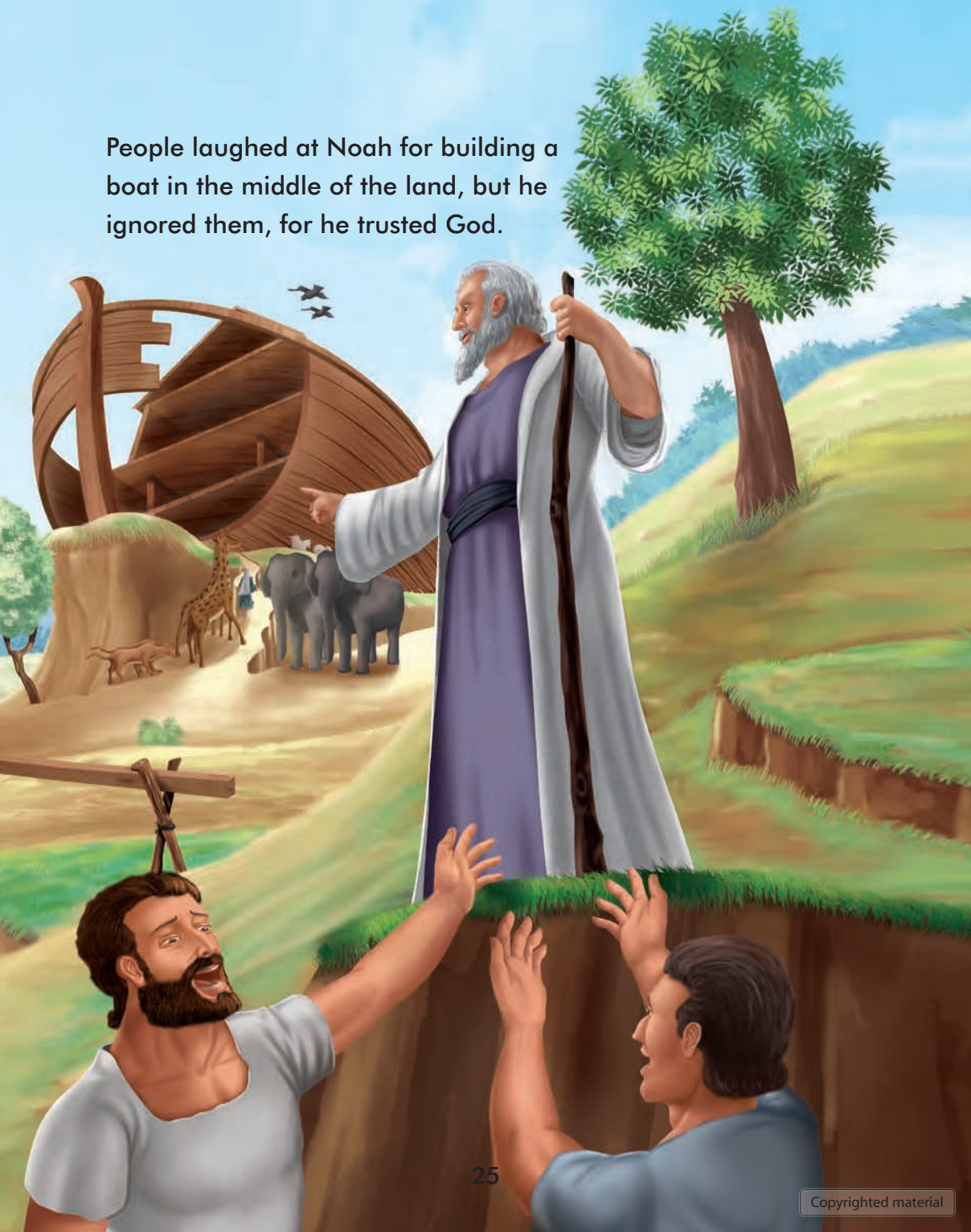

Genesis 7–9
